



Downloading eBooks onto a Kindle Using DigitalLibraryNJ

Your Nutley Public Library card required is required to download eBooks.

Step 1:



Using your computer, go to nutley.bccls.org and click on the bottom of the page.

Step 2: When the Digital Library NJ page opens, Click the **Login** tab on the top of the page and select Bergen County Cooperative Library System (BCCLS) from the drop down menu of library systems. After selecting BCCLS type your library card number to login. When logged in you have the ability to change checkout times from 10 to 14 days.

Step 2:



Next, navigate to the right side of the screen and click to browse through the Kindle eBook collection. You can also narrow results by keyword or select to only show copies available, on the top of the page.

Search Results

Search within results:

Only show titles with copies available

If desired title is checked out you can click **Place a Hold**, to be added to waiting list. You will enter your email address and receive an email notice when eBook is available. If a title of interest is available, you will click **Add to Cart**.

Step 3:

After adding a book to cart, you will then click the 'Get for Kindle' button. This opens the Amazon.com website. You will be required to sign in with your Amazon.com account if you are not already logged in to Amazon.

Step 4:

At Amazon, select a Kindle device or Kindle reading app. Click the 'Get library book' button and sync your device or app to download the book. An active Wi-Fi connection is required for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Connect to your Kindle to the Wi-Fi network.

Note: eBooks from Digital Library NJ require an active Wi-Fi connection for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Library books will not be delivered via your Kindle's 3G connection. If trying to send to a Kindle device and do you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you may instead choose to load your library book via USB and transfer the book manually by connecting the Kindle to your computer.

Final Step:

After the lending period expires, the book will no longer be readable. You can delete it by selecting the item, and click remove from device.
