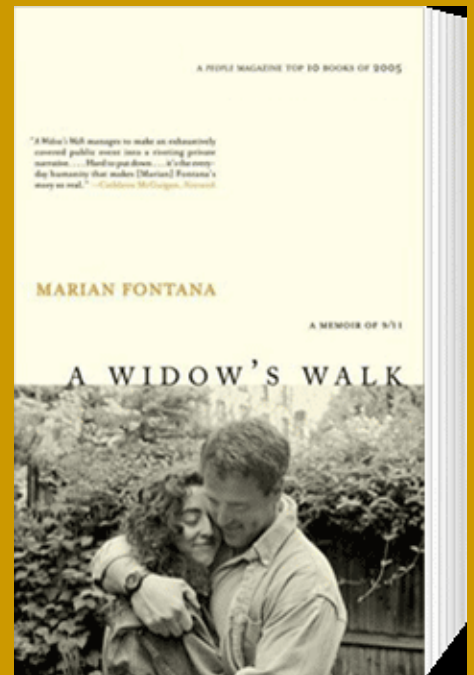

Her work has been chronicled in The New York Times, The Daily News, New York Post, Washington Post and the LA Times. She has appeared as a guest on CNN, MSNBC, Dateline NBC, Larry King, Charlie Rose and many others.**
